## 2003 – 2004 Legislative Session

AB 1137 (Reyes) Charter School Renewal N/A  
**(The Association was not in existence when this measure went through the legislature)**  
This bill provided oversight standards as well as a method to review academic performance and ensure that charter schools are fulfilling their purpose of increasing innovation and learning opportunities while being accountable for achieving measurable student outcomes. It also specified that the chartering authority, instead of the State Board of Education, may determine for the purpose of renewal that the academic performance of the charter school is at least equal to the academic performance of the public schools that the charter school pupils would otherwise attend.  
**Signed by Governor**

AB 1860 (Reyes) Charter School Petitions and PRA Oppose  
This measure added a compliance audit requirement to charter school annual audits; prohibited charter schools from expelling a pupil solely on academic performance, required charter schools to notify the appropriate school district governing board and county office of education when a pupil is expelled or leaves school without graduating or completing the school year, and required charter schools to comply with the Public Records Act.  
**Vetoed by Governor**

## 2005 – 2006 Legislative Session

AB 740 (Huff) Charter School Block Grant Sponsor  
This measure revised the entire charter school block grant to gain greater equity between charter schools and traditional schools, in terms of funded categorical programs.  
**Signed by Governor**

AB 2717 (Walters) Charter School Bonding Sponsor  
Allowed the California School Finance Authority (in the State Treasurer's Office) to issue bonds on behalf of charter schools for financing working capital and capital improvements.  
**Signed by Governor**

AB 2954 (Liu) Charter School Petitions Oppose  
AB 2954 allowed a charter petition to be denied because it causes a negative fiscal impact to the school district but also says that cannot be a reason for denial of a charter renewal petition. Additionally, it allowed a school district to require that a charter school describe how it will provide free and reduced price meals to eligible pupils as a condition for initial charter approval.  
**Vetoed by Governor**

SB 604 (Aanestad) Advanced Apportionment Sponsor  
This bill provided that a growing charter school can receive advanced apportionment funding for each pupil when it adds a new grade.  
**Signed by Governor**

SB 846 (Aanestad) County Treasuries Sponsor  
This bill authorized a county treasurer of the charter-authorizing local education agency (i.e., the treasurer located in the jurisdiction of the school district or county office of education that authorized the charter school) to temporarily transfer funds to a charter school if all charter school funds are in the County Treasurer's custody and constitutional requirements are met.  
**Failed in the Assembly**

### **2007 – 2008 Legislative Session**

AB 177 (Bass) Soledad Enrichment Center Support  
AB 177 extended the charter for the Soledad Enrichment Action Charter Schools in Los Angeles and continued their unique funding model.  
**Signed by Governor**

AB 766 (Walters) Field Trip Immunity Sponsor  
This measure extended field trip immunity to all charter schools in California.  
**Signed by Governor**

AB 1230 (Laird) Pupil Health Screening Oppose  
This bill would have required charter schools to provide pupil sight and hearing test and scoliosis screenings. A charter school would have been authorized to contract with a school district or county office of education to provide the test and screening.  
**This measure was amended to no longer affect charter schools.**

AB 1281 (Soto) Charter petitions Oppose  
This measure would have required charter schools to explicitly say in their charter petition how special educational services would be provided to each student. Additionally, the measure would have required charter schools to revise their suspension and expulsion procedures.  
**Vetoed by Governor**

AB 1868 (Walters) Tort Claims Act Sponsor  
This measure would have declared charter schools school districts for purposes of the Tort Claims Act.  
**Failed in the Assembly**

AB 2115 (Mullin) Conflict of Interest Oppose  
AB 2115 would have placed draconian conflict of interest provisions on charter schools.  
**Vetoed by Governor**

SB 20 (Torlakson) Facility Grants Support  
SB 20 provided \$18 million for the facility grant program which provides funding for charter schools residing in an attendance area of 70% or greater free and reduced lunch.  
**Signed by Governor**

SB 658 (Romero) Facilities Funding Co-sponsor  
This bill phases out the Year-Round School Grant Program and shifts the funds over to the SB 740 Charter School Facility Grant Program, nearly \$100 million over five years.  
**Signed by Governor**

## **2009-2010 Legislative Session**

ACR 49 (Evans)                      Tort Claims Act                      Sponsor  
This resolution authorizes the California Law Revision Commission to study whether charter schools should be treated as public entities for the purposes of the Tort Claims Act.  
**Adopted by Legislature**

AB 572 (Brownley)                      Conflict of Interest Policies                      Oppose  
This measure requires charter schools to comply with punitive conflict of interest policies, including the Political Reform Act of 1974.  
**Vetoed by the Governor**

AB 788 (Swanson)                      Prohibition of Funds to Charter Schools                      Oppose  
This bill prohibits the Superintendent and the appointed administrator from transferring or allocating any district funds to a charter school in the Oakland Unified School District.  
**Failed in the Assembly**

AB 980 (Swanson)                      Emergency Apportionment Repayment                      Oppose  
Requires charter schools in a district who is repaying an emergency apportionment to pay a prorated amount of the annual payment made by the district on the apportionment, and deducts the prorated amount from the general purpose entitlement funding calculated for the charter school.  
**Failed in the Senate**

AB 1909 (Nestande)                      Alternative Authorizers                      Sponsor  
Authorizes a charter school petition to be submitted for approval to the governing board of a community college district if the petition proposes the operation of a charter school within the county in which the community college maintains a campus.  
**Failed in the Assembly**

AB 1950 (Brownley)                      Charter School Operations                      Oppose  
Makes various changes to charter school law, including creating a charter school supplement to the audit guide, prohibiting a charter school from operating as, or from being operated by, a for-profit corporation, and changes petition requirements and renewal requirements.  
**Stalled in the Senate**

AB 1982 (Ammiano)                      Charter School Cap                      Oppose  
Limits the total number of charter schools authorized to operate in California to 1,450, and included new nepotism rules for charter schools.  
**Failed in the Senate**

AB 1991 (Arambula)                      Academic Accountability                      Sponsor  
Makes changes to the renewal process and criteria for charter schools to increase academic accountability, and allows for a ten year renewal of a charter petition.

Failed in the Assembly

AB 2320 (Swanson)                      Changes to Petition and Appeal Process                      Oppose  
Makes various changes to the Charter Schools Act, including deleting the authority to appeal a denial to the State Board of Education and adding additional petition requirements.

Failed in the Senate

AB 2363 (Mendoza)                      Petition Signature Requirements                      Oppose  
Requires that ½ of the classified employees at a charter school site (or proposed site), in addition to ½ of the certificated employees, sign a petition for a charter school.

Failed in the Senate

SB 191 (Wright)                      General Purpose Entitlement Calculations                      Sponsor  
This bill endeavors to resolve implementation issues with SB 319, which changed the funding status for charter high school conversions in unified school districts, by applying the statewide revenue limit rate for charter schools to conversion charter schools in unified school districts.

Signed by Governor

SB 378 (Romero)                      SB 740 Funding                      Sponsor  
This bill expands eligibility for the SB 740 facilities grant program if funds remain after charter schools that meet the existing free and reduced price meals threshold are funded. Also expands eligibility for units of average daily attendance generated through nonclassroom-based instruction.

Held in Senate Appropriations Committee

SB 592 (Romero)                      Charter School Facilities Title                      Sponsor  
This bill allows local government entities or charter schools to hold title to their facilities under certain circumstances. The bill also authorizes charter schools to request a school district to transfer title to project facilities to the charter school or local entity, if the district entered into an agreement prior to 1/1/2010 to hold title to the project facilities.

Signed by Governor
